DATE CHANGE FOR 2018



Cooper Events, organisers of the annual Buxton Antiques Fair, have announced a change of date of for this year's 2018 fair.

Originally schedule for 17-29 May, the late finishing refurbishment of the Octagon Building at the Pavilion Gardens, which started more than 2 years ago, has meant that for 2018 the fair will move to 13-16 September.

Speaking on behalf of Cooper Events, organiser Sue Ede said: 'For the past two years while the venue was being refurbished we have held the fair in a marquee situated adjacent to the Pavilion complex. Our exhibitors and visitors were expecting to move back into the familiar surroundings of the Octagon building with its promised redecoration. Now, due to the overrun of the work, we must reschedule. After much careful consideration, we have chosen 13-16 September.'

The fair is expected to feature approximately 45 exhibitors showing a wide range of traditional antiques, fine art, collectors pieces, jewellery, decorative items, contemporary art and sculpture.

The Fair brings together dealers from across England and is widely respected as the longest continually running antiques fair in the country.

Public Admission is £5.00. The 2018 event will open with a VIP Reception.
