Yorkshire Paintings Feature at Harrogate Pavilions Antiques Fair

Paintings of Knaresborough Castle (*right*) and the Pontefract races (*below*) will feature in a display of paintings by the artist Gordon Radford at The Pavilions of Harrogate Decorative, Antiques & Art Fair at the Great Yorkshire Showground, Harrogate, 3rd – 5th May 2019.



The collection of paintings, which come direct from the artist's studio, are being sold by his son, Paul, will be exhibited by Sutcliffe Contemporary, the Harrogate gallery who show regularly at the popular Pavilions of Harrogate fair together with other leading Yorkshire galleries and specialist antique dealers.



A highly respected painter, Gordon Radford (1936-2015) was born in Oldham and a member of the Manchester Academy of Fine Arts. He exhibited at the Royal Society of Arts in London. And was widely acclaimed for his impressionistic style. He was widely travelled and often painted the classic views of Venice and Majorca. On sale at the fair will also be views of Knaresborough Castle and Pontefract Castle, Cafe Florian, Venice, the Bridge of the Rhine and Soller, Majorca. Prices will range from £750 for the smaller works to £2,500 for the larger pieces.

The Pavilions of Harrogate Fair brings together many dealers from the north of England. From Harrogate, English antique furniture specialists Elaine Phillips returns to the fair with a fine collection of 18th and 19th century pieces; and other Yorkshire dealers include Chris Holmes Antiques from Knaresborough offers all kinds of unusual decorative; Mark Buckley Antiques shows fine English furniture and bronzes, John Newton Antiques specialising in 19th and 20th century porcelain and studio art pottery; and Walker Galleries, from Harrogate, with 18th, 19th and 20th century paintings.

Newcomers showing for the first time include Hispanic Antiques showing Spanish antique and decorated furniture and unusual *objet's d'art*.

In other collecting fields will be Garrett & Hurst with 19th and 20th century bronze sculpture; Rowles Fine Art with paintings and sculpture; jewellers Plaza and Shapiro & Co; Roger De Ville with early English pottery and Brian Ashbee from Bristol with ceramics, glass and furniture.
